The Ph.D. Dissertation Award will recognize research excellence and contribution to the profession by a doctoral candidate in the area of aquaculture economics, marketing and management. The recipients of the award will receive an honorarium of \$2,000 and reimbursement of \$1,000 for travel to attend a professional aquaculture meeting*. An honorable mentioned dissertation will also receive a travel award.

Nomination requirements

- Eligible for nomination are final or submitted dissertations with a completion/acceptance date during calendar year 2016.
- A letter of nomination from the department head (or chair) or the main professor where the dissertation was completed. The letter should state the nominee's name, title of the dissertation, a nomination or recommendation from the major advisor, name of the institution, and a brief outline of the merits of the research.
- A soft copy of the dissertation in English. Deadline for receipt of entries for dissertations completed in 2016 is **January 15, 2017**.
